### **Update from YIG Fredericton:**

**CLAY 2018** - Canadian Lutheran Anglican Youth gathering happening on **August 15-19, 2018**. Almost one year away! In 2016 we sent one team of 5 youth and 2 leaders (myself included) to PEI and in 2018 we want to increase our team! CLAY was an amazing experience and I cannot wait to go again. It is in **Thunder Bay, ON** and will require more planning and coordinating compared to going to PEI. Theme, fees and registration information is still TBA however, if it is similar to 2016 the cost would be \$500 per person plus flight. There are some porter flights available that we can organize which would make it cheaper. The registration would be early February and it was sold out within two weeks. If you are seriously thinking about forming a team please begin in the Fall. I will be forming a team from the Saint John/Grand Bay area but I will also be coordinating the Diocese of Fredericton teams. Please contact me if you are interested.

**Diocesan Youth Ministry Conference** is happening at Sackville, NB on September 30th from 10am -4pm. This year's theme is Connecting...Family, Youth and Community. We will have guest speakers, workshops and a chance to mingle with other youth leaders in the Diocese. I highly recommend that you, your other youth leaders and volunteers and/or synod/youth delegates to attend. **DYC** - Diocesan Youth Conference - We are partnering with our sister Diocese of Nova Scotia/PEI for a youth conference happening on October 27-29 at Camp Malagash Bible Camp in Nova Scotia.
