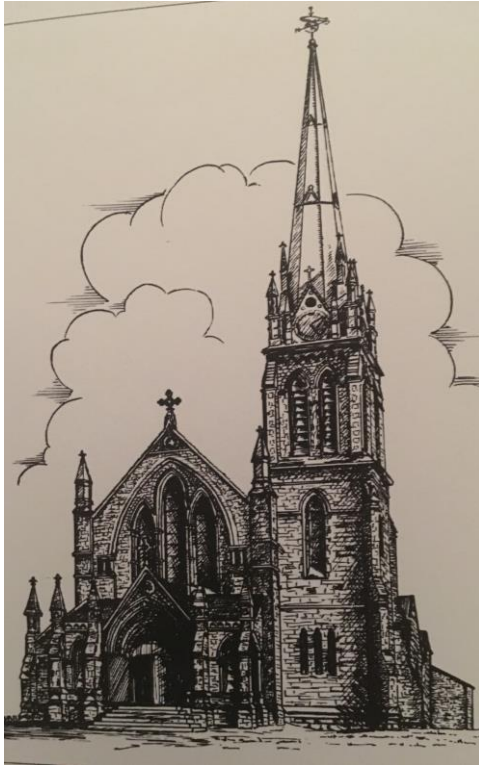

## **Pastor's Thoughts;**

The Theme of the Diocese of Fredericton's 136<sup>th</sup> Synod held on November 4th, 2018 was 'Walk the Walk (Ephesians 4:1) ***"As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received."*** To help us with this focus, Bishop David Edwards in his charge emphasised the need for us to live out our faith through action (Monday through Saturday). For the church to thrive we need to create a space for reaching out – for mission – outside these walls. We are called to put our faith into action.

To support this theme, we were introduced to the BELLS model which is described in more detail in Michael Frost's book titled Surprise the World. BELLS is an acronym for the five habits of highly missional people, Bless, Eat, Listen, Learn and Sent.

**Bless** – If you bless three people every week, you're going to become a very generous person

**Eat** – If you eat with others, you'll develop a greater capacity for hospitality.

**Listen** – If you foster the habit of listening to the Holy Spirit, you'll become an increasingly Spirit-led person.

**Learn** – If you're learning Christ, it's fair to assume you'll become more and more Christlike.

**Sent** – If you're journaling the myriad ways you've been sent into your world, you'll increasingly see yourself as a sent one, or a missionary in your own neighborhood.

I have ordered twelve of these books from the Diocese and will look at a Study Program to explore this after Easter. This fits our Vision perfectly – to be a Warm Attractive and Thriving Christian Community.
