Trinity Corporation is in need to secure a person who has the interest in being the Treasurer, effective January 1st, 2019. Trinity has been extremely fortunate to have the support of Ms. Debbie Hughes over the past years as our Treasurer and we thank her for her tremendous commitment to Trinity and the role as our Treasurer. It is her desire to retire from this position by the end of the year. Trinity needs to take over this role effective January 2019, while having the opportunity to work alongside our current Treasurer for the remainder of 2018. Damascus Refugee Two Program - On Tuesday, July 10th, the Damascus Group (St. Mary's St. Bartholomew, Stone and Trinity churches) welcomed the Ramadan Family not only to Canada, but to our great city, Saint John. Their arrival was a result of many hours of effort from them while living in exile in Turkey for the past years, and committed members here with our team. This is a private sponsorship, as there are no further government funds going forward. The annual cost is \$37,000 to be covered by the three church families which will be a result of offerings dedicated to their support along with a host of fundraising activities over the fall and winter. Simple math equates to \$12,333 per parish for the year or \$237 per week or \$10 by 25 parishioners per week the price of 7 small cups of Tim Coffee per week. You will find Offertory Envelopes on the table as you enter for your use if so desired, please indicate your envelope number for income tax purposes. This is in part what we are asked to do as missional peoples. Should you have any questions, please contact Rev. Steven G. Scribner.

The Ramadan family of 5, Lubna and her 4 children are now happily settled in their apartment. Last week, furniture was obtained and moved to their home on Main Street, in the North End. There are few items left to collect, and I will be in contact with those who offered items, and collect them this week. The next items on the agenda are finalizing Medicare applications, etc. and getting the necessary paperwork completed, to ensure they are enrolled in English classes and the children get enrolled for school in September. For fundraising activities we have tentatively booked Stone Church for October 27th. We plan on holding a Music Concert, Silent Auction and Dessert Party. Preliminary talks have been held with possible performers, but nothing has been finalized yet, as we just set a date. We also plan on holding a Painting Parting, hosted by local artist Joanne Fitzpatrick at a later date. Stay tuned for more details. I would like to thank all those who have offered to help with the fundraising events and providing household items, as well as all the support and encouragement provided. Stay tuned for more updates, as we move forward in this very important ministry.
