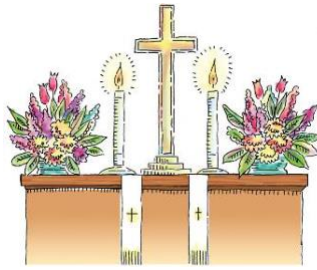

Each summer Inner City Youth Ministry: runs programming in the South End and Waterloo Village neighbourhoods to address the ongoing issue of poverty and food insecurity. Last summer our Lunch Connection Summer Edition provided ~1400 lunches (Sandwich, fruit, and snack item) and our Backpack program supported ~30 families weekly with a recipe, 15\$ worth of ingredients and several easy grab snack items for kids along with a book and activities. Between those two programs that's about 2720 individual granola bars, apple sauces, fruit snacks, or other **peanut free** "school snack items". We are hoping that Trinity Church would help us bless our neighborhood by collecting some of these snack items for us.
