#### THE BLESSING OF THE PALMS

Priest: The Lord be with you. **Answer: And with thy spirit.** 

Priest: Let us pray.

Assist us mercifully with thy help, O Lord God of our salvation; that we may enter with joy upon the meditation of those mighty acts, whereby thou hast given unto us life and immortality, through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.** 

THE LESSON: Luke 19: 28-40 Judi Harvey Isaac

But Jesus turned to them and said, "Daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for me, but weep for yourselves and for your children. For the days are surely coming when they will say, 'Blessed are the barren, and the wombs that never bore, and the breasts that never nursed.' Then they will begin to say to the mountains, 'Fall on us'; and to the hills, 'Cover us.' For if they do this when the wood is green, what will happen when it is dry?"

Two others also, who were criminals, were led away to be put to death with him. When they came to the place that is called The Skull, they crucified Jesus there with the criminals, one on his right and one on his left. Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing." And they cast lots to divide his clothing. And the people stood by, watching; but the leaders scoffed at him, saying, "He saved others; let him save himself if he is the Messiah of God, his chosen one!" The soldiers also mocked him, coming up and offering him sour wine, and saying, "If you are the King of the Jews, save yourself!" There was also an inscription over him, "This is the King of the Jews." One of the criminals who were hanged there kept deriding him and saying, "Are you not the Messiah? Save yourself and us!" But the other rebuked him, saying, "Do you not fear God, since you are under the same sentence of condemnation?

Priest: The Lord be with you. **Answer:** And with thy spirit.

Priest: Lift up your hearts.

**Answer:** We lift them up unto the Lord.

Priest: Let us bless the Lord.

**Answer:** It is meet and right so to do.

It is very meet, right and our bounden duty, that we should at all times, and in all places, bless thee, O Lord, Almighty, Everlasting God, for and by thy whole creation; but especially do we praise thee, at this time, for the mighty acts whereby thou has redeemed us, through thy Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. And we beseech thee, O Lord, send thy blessing upon us who now make our prayer unto thee, and sanctify to our use these branches of palm; that we who bear them in the Name may ever hail Him as our King, through the same thy Son, Jesus Christ our Lord, to Whom with Thee and the Holy Spirit, be all honour and glory, and world without end. Amen.

## THE PASSION OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST ACCORDING TO ST. MATTHEW

N – Narrator Spencer Belyea ALL – The Crowd

P – Pilate David Goss + - Voice of Jesus Rev. Steven C1 – The Soldiers Jim McKenna C2 – The Priests Jim McKenna

W – Wife of Pilate Mary Louise B J – Judas Jim McKenna

- N WHEN the morning was come, all the chief priests and elders of the people took counsel against Jesus, to put him to death. And when they had bound him, they led him away, and delivered him to Pontius Pilate, the governor. Then Judas, who had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, saying,
- J I have sinned, in that I have betrayed the innocent blood.
- N And they said,
- C2 What is that to us? See thou to that.
- N And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself. And the chief priests took the silver pieces, and said,
- C2 It is not lawful for to put them into treasury, because it is the price of blood.
- N And they took counsel, and bought with them the potters' field, to bury strangers in. Wherefore that field was called, The Field of Blood, unto this day. (Then was fulfilled that which was spoken by Jeremiah the prophet, saying, And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the price of him that was valued, whom they of the children of Israel did value, and gave them for the potters' field, as the Lord appointed me.)
- N And Jesus stood before the governor; and the governor asked him, saying,
- P Art thou the King of the Jews?
- N And Jesus said unto him,
- + Thou sayest.
- N And when he was accused by the chief priests and elders, he answered nothing. Then saith Pilate unto him,
- P Hearest thou not how many things they witness against thee?

- N And he gave him no answer, not even to a single charge, insomuch that the governor marvelled greatly. Now at the feast the governor was want to release unto the people a prisoner, whom they would. And they had then a notable prisoner, called Barabbas. Therefore, when they were gathered together, Pilate said unto them,
- P Whom will ye that I release unto you? Barabbas, or Jesus which is called the Christ?
- N For he knew that for envy they had delivered him. And while he was sitting on the judgement-seat, his wife sent unto him, saying,
- W Have thou nothing to do with that just man: for I have suffered many things this day in a dream because of him.
- N But the chief priests and elders persuaded the multitudes that they should ask Barabbas, and destroy Jesus. The governor answered and said unto them,
- P Which of the two will ye that I release unto you?
- N They said,

#### **ALL BARABBAS**

- N Pilate saith unto them,
- P What shall I do then with Jesus which is called the Christ?
- N They all say unto him,

#### ALL LET HIM BE CRUCIFIED.

- N And the governor said,
- P Why, what evil hath he done?
- N But they cried out the more, saying,

#### ALL LET HIM BE CRUCIFIED.

- N When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but that the tumult increased, he took water, and washed his hands before the multitude, saying,
- P I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see ye to it.
- N Then answered all the people, and said,

#### ALL ALL HIS BLOOD BE ON US, AND ON OUR CHILDREN.

N Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered him to be crucified. Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus into the common hall, and gathered unto him the whole band of soldiers. And they stripped him, and put on him a scarlet robe.

And when they had plaited a crown of thorns, they put it upon his head, and a reed in his right hand: and they bowed the knee before him, and mocked him, saying,

#### C1 Hail, King of the Jews!

And they spit upon him, and took the reed, and smote him Ν on the head. And after that they had mocked him, they took the robe off from him, and put his own raiment on him, and led him away to crucify him. And as they came out they found a man of Cyrene, Simon by name; him they compelled to bear his cross. And when they were come unto a place called Golgotha, that is to say, a place of a skull, they gave him vinegar to drink mingled with gall; and when he has tasted thereof, he would not drink. And they crucified him, and parted his garments, casting lots. And sitting down they watched him there; and set up over his head his accusation written, THIS IS JESUS THE KING OF THE JEWS. Then there were two thieves crucified with him; one on the right hand, and another on the left. And they that passed by reviled him, wagging their heads, and saying,

# ALL THOU THAT DESTROYEST THE TEMPLE, AND BUILDEST IT IN THREE DAYS, SAVE YOURSELF: IF THOU BE THE SON OF GOD, COME DOWN FROM THE CROSS.

- N Likewise also the chief priests mocking him, with the scribes and elders, said,
- C2 He saved others, himself he cannot save: if he be the King of Israel, let him now come down from the cross, and we will believe him. He trusted in God; let him deliver him now, if he will have him: for he said, I am the Son of God.
- N The thieves also, which were crucified with him, cast the same in his teeth. Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour. And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying,
- + Eli, eli, lama sa-bac-thanee
- N That is to say,
- + My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?

N Some of them that stood there, when they heard that, saith,

#### ALL THIS MAN CALLETH FOR ELIJAH.

And straight away one of them ran, and took a sponge, and filled it with vinegar, and put it on a reed, and gave it to him to drink. The rest said,

### ALL LET BE. LET US SEE WHETHER ELIJAH WILL COME TO SAVE HIM.

N Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, gave up the spirit. SILENCE

N And behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom, and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent, and the graves were opened, and many bodies of saints which slept arose, and came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many. Now when the centurion and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying,

#### ALL TRULY THIS WAS THE SON OF GOD.

N Almighty God, whose most dear Son went not up to joy but first he suffered pain, and entered not into glory before he was crucified; Mercifully grant that we, walking in the way of the cross, may find it none other than the way of life and peace; through the same thy Son Jesus Christ our Lord.
